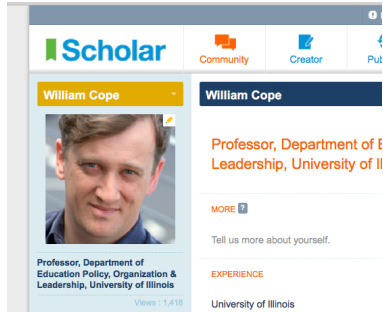


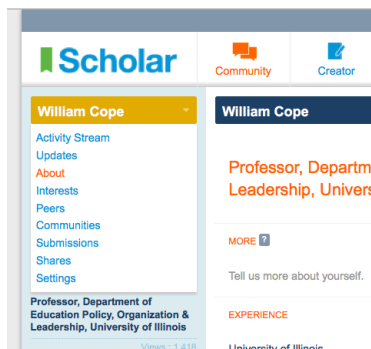

2.3 Sharing More about Yourself



2.3.1: To create or change your avatar, hover over the image. You will see a small edit pencil in the top right corner.

- Click [Save and Apply].

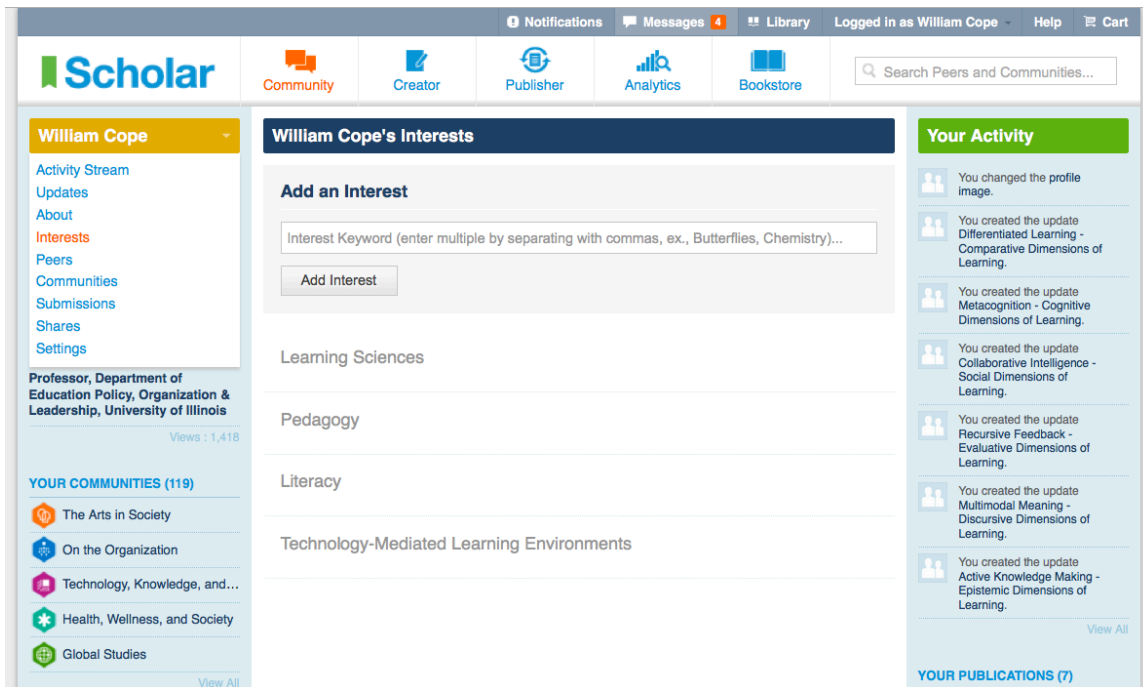


2.3.2: To add information about yourself, select “About” in the pull down menu behind your name.

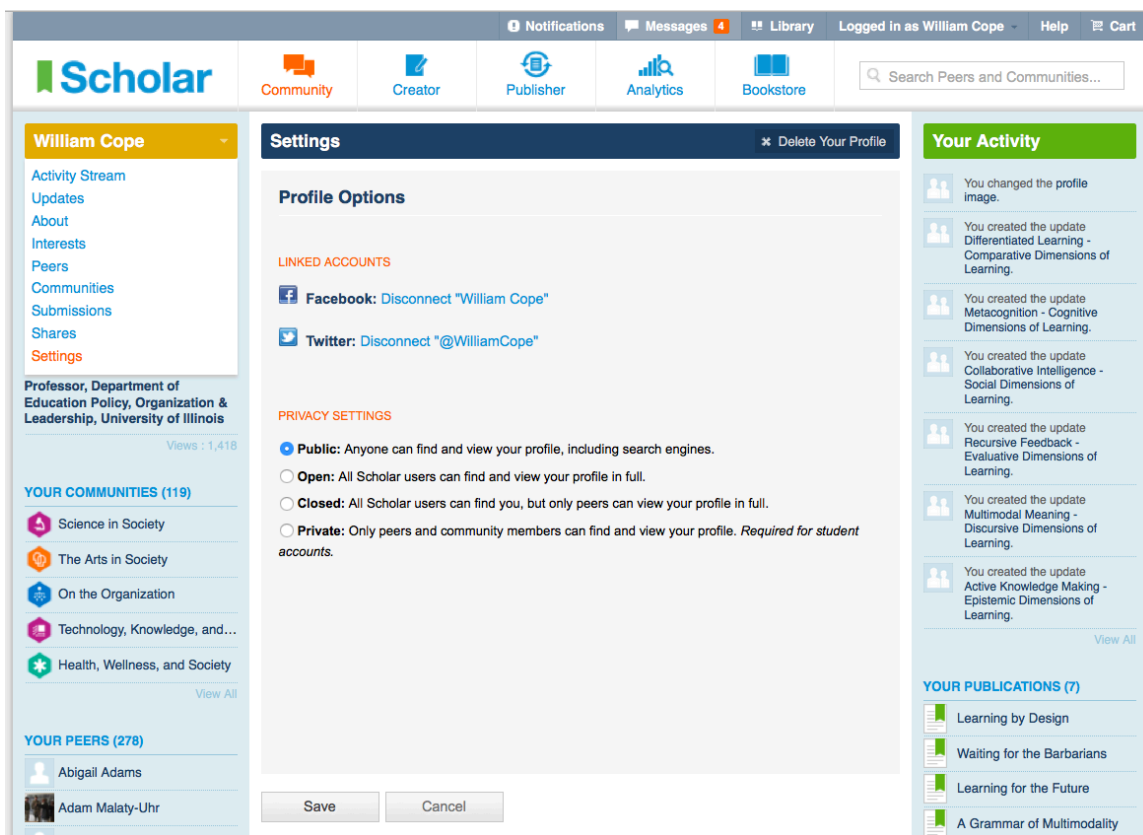
