### 3.1.1: Creator is:

- A multimodal writing space where you can write text as well as include images, videos, audio, datasets, and external web media within that text.
- A social writing space where you can work with others in the following roles:
  - **Creator:** One or more people who are going to be named as the creators of this work.
  - **Contributor:** A person who offers feedback on a work, including peer reviews, annotations, and publication recommendations.
  - **Publishing Admin:** A person who manages the publishing process, from draft, to peer feedback, to revision, to editing and final publication.
