




## 3.6 Checker





**3.6.1:** Checker is more than a simple grammar and spelling checker. Rather than saying you are right or wrong, it suggests changes that you evaluate for yourself as well as names the change type. To run the checker on the currently viewed element, go to Feedback => Checker.

**3.6.2:** When you hover over an item that Checker has identified potentially needing attention, that item will also be highlighted in the body of the element.



**3.6.3:** Use the blue arrow to open the information below that item.

- You will see a suggestion type and a suggestion. In this case above, Checker is saying that “evidenced” is a complex expression, and you may want to use the word “shown.”
- If you agree with Checker, select the green check mark/tick to make the change.
- If you have finished considering this change suggestion, you may choose to delete the suggestion.
