Schedule List or CalendarView

There are two ways to explore the conference Schedule: **List View** and **Calendar View**. When you first open the Schedule, it **defaults to List View**.

List View

Format:

- Toggle between:
- In-Person
 - Online
 - Asynchronous

This allows you to view presentations by delivery format

Search Tools / Filters


You can:

- **Search** by keywords or presenter names
- **Filter** by My Program, Room, Theme, or Presentation Type

These tools help you quickly locate sessions most relevant to your interests.

Conference Events & Presentations

- Presentations are listed day by day
- **Conference Events** (such as plenaries or keynotes) are open to all delegates



Days

- Each conference day appears as a separate tab.
- When you move between days, your selected **Format** and **Filters** remain active.

Calendar View

Switch to Calendar View to see sessions mapped by time and room.

Save Schedule


In List View, you can download a **PDF** of your current schedule, including any active filters.

Schedule On-Site Format

In-Person, Online, and Asynchronous presentations are integrated into a single scholarly environment. However, each format has subtle differences in how it appears. Let's begin with the **On-Site Format**

List View

Filters:

- Search the schedule by keyword or presenter name
- Filter by **My Program**, Room, Theme, or Presentation Type

My Program

- Presentations you've **starred** (your saved program)

Presentations


- Individual presentation listings show **time and room details**
- Select a presentation to open its Presentation Page (**abstract, presenters, discussion, and digital media**)

Comment

- Direct link to the **Discussion Board** where you can talk with presenter.


Digital Media

- Select the **paperclip icon** to view a delegate's uploaded digital media. If no media is available, you may submit a request directly from the **Presentation Page**.
- Digital media is central to Online and Asynchronous engagement, but it is also **available for In-Person sessions** to extend the conversation beyond the room. This content remains accessible, allowing you to return, revisit, and continue the dialogue over time.



Calendar View

In Calendar View, presentations are laid out by time and room, making it easier to scan each day at a glance—while also clearly highlighting Themed Panels and Emerging Scholar sessions.




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Schedule Online vs Asynchronous Formats

Online sessions are live events (e.g., Zoom sessions or workshops) with scheduled times. **Asynchronous sessions** are pre-recorded presentations with supporting digital media, available on demand.


Online Sessions

- Appear at specific times in **Calendar View**
- They include access to **live meeting links**
- They support **real-time participation**




Asynchronous Sessions

- Available throughout the conference period
- Designed for flexible participation across time zones
- **No fixed session time**



Format

- Use this **toggle** to switch between formats—In-Person, Online, and Asynchronous—to view presentations within each mode of participation.




ENGAGE Presentation Page Details + Digital Media

Become Peers


Connect with presenters as peers to:



Engage in open discussion:



- Ask **questions**

Tip: If there is no Digital Media you can request it


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Live Thread
